
We have received more than 150 full length papers in this conference. All the submissions were underwent the peer-review process which comprised expert reviewers. The entire process, which includes the submissions, review and acceptance processes was done electronically. Total 75 papers were registered and selected for presentation in to the various conference tracks as follows:

Track 1 was Circuits & Systems (ECE-1) in which 14 papers were registered



Track 2 was the combination of theme like *Microwave and Antennas*, *Communication Technologies and Signal Processing* in which 10 papers were registered. Track 3 was Network and Computing- Cloud Computing & IoT (CSE-1), 12 papers were registered.
