

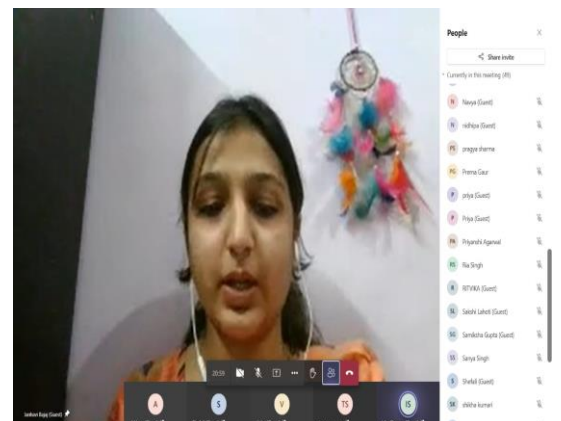


PLACEMENT TALK

On the 6th of February UTKARSH – Student Branch of CSI Lakshmangarh Chapter organized a Placement Talk from 5pm to 7pm. The event was open to all the students of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of the SET department. This event was a transformative event in which students heard directly from experienced seniors and had the opportunity to interact and discuss placement readiness tactics.

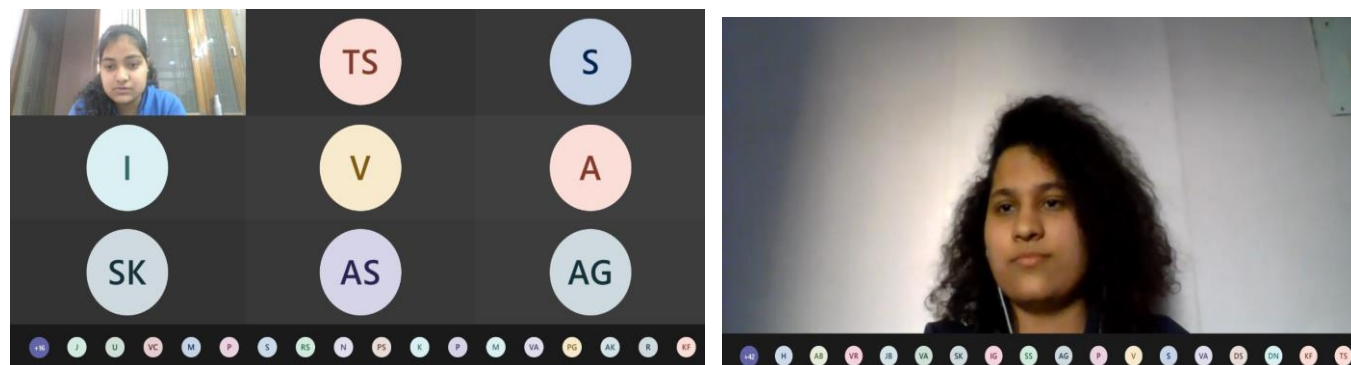
The event featured ten speakers from the current 4th year who have been placed in companies such as Dell, American Express, Paytm, Athena Health, VMware, JP Morgan, and many others. They discussed the importance of placement and their valuable experience on how they prepared for and completed their placements, as well as how they got placed in the companies they desired.

The speakers began by providing information on the selection process and the types of employees that an organization desires, with a focus on group discussion, interviews, and soft skills. The selection procedure differs from one organization to the next, and candidates should plan accordingly. Almost every company's first round was a code round, in which candidates had to solve two or three coding questions in a set period of time, which may range from two to three hours, with some multiple choice questions. There are several further rounds after that, including technical, group discussion, PowerPoint presentation, and HR.



They also discussed what areas of academe one should study to prepare for coding and technical rounds, such as data structures, operating systems, database management systems, and puzzles. Geeks for geeks, interview bits, and leetcode were among the resources they provided from where they studied for their placement. They also offered interview tips on how to portray oneself, what to do if you get stuck, don't know or recall something, and how to deal with nerves. They also talked about what to put on your resume and what not to put on it, as well as making sure that they are aware of everything you have written on your CV.

The event concluded with a question and answer session where attendees asked a variety of questions about placement, such as how to find a decent job, growth rates, MNC placements, and business eligibility criteria for their different divisions. Participants were encouraged to study hard, enhance soft skills, and participate in extracurricular activities in order to develop their personalities.
