





## CSI Tech Event (17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> Nov 2021)

UTKARSH – CSI Student Branch, MUST Lakshmangarh have organized series of events from 17<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021. The events were open to all the students of all years of the SET department and it saw participation of 200+ students.

The first day began with an Opening Ceremony which was conducted virtually from 9.00 AM – 10.00 AM, in which all the information regarding the upcoming events was shared. It was followed by the content writing competition where participants were provided with the topics, and the rules were discussed. Participants were given the time duration of 12 hrs to submit their writeups which was till 11.00 pm. This competition gave students an opportunity to showcase their creative writing skills. Next was the Technovation event which was held from 11:30 am onwards, where participants were assigned a case study and were asked to share their ideas by the end of day in the form of a presentation. Based on the presentation, students were selected to showcase their ppt in front of the judges on the following day.

The last event of the day was the coding competition which was at 2:30 pm where students participated enthusiastically. The test window was open from 2.30 pm to 6.30 pm and the test duration was 60, 90, 100 minutes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year respectively on the Hackerrank platform. As this was the very first coding competition for many students they got to learn about online coding platforms and competitions.

On the next day, the Technovation presentation took place and the winners were chosen by the judges, Mr. P K Bishnoi and Mr. Vinay Verma. It was followed by the CSI Drive event. The drive started at 5:00 pm, where students were given information about the CSI and the privilege of being its member.
